## No. International Students : Classified by Country (Top 15 Countries)

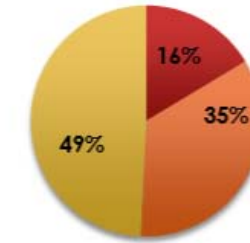

# Learning in PSU

Prince of Songkla University has 54 Ph.D. programs, 109 Master's programs, 2 higher graduate diplomas and 1 graduate diploma, about 2,000 graduate students attend the faculties and research centers in Prince of Songkla University, with about 400 students at the Ph.D level.

All academic activities are run by The Education Innovative Learning Academy and the Center for Learning Promotion and Development emphasis on OBE, Active Learning. Co-operative education (co-op training) as well as Work Integrated Learning (WIL) have been applied to many disciplines with co-operations from the industries/enterprises to promote student innovations.



Available online learning platforms are PSU Learning Management System (hosting more than 570 courses across 5 campuses) and PSU MOOC (hosting about 40 courses).

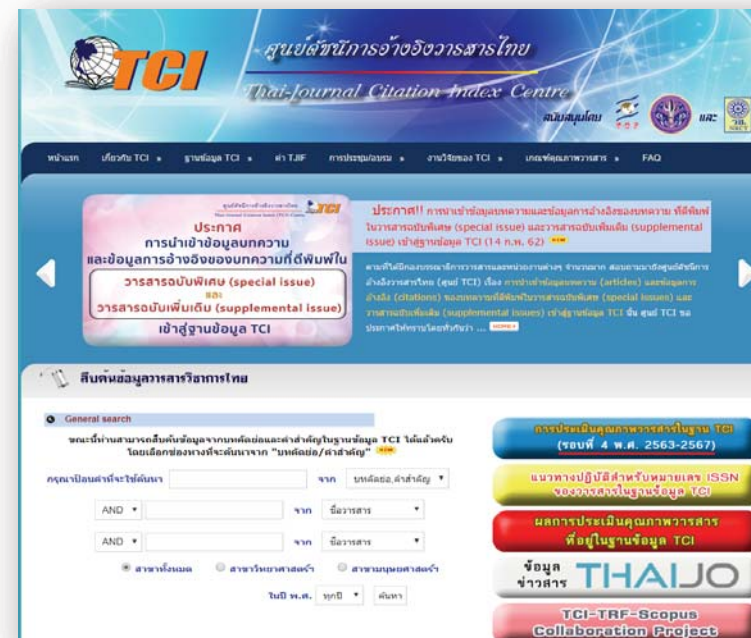
## ROLE OF BUU LIBRARY to support Education

# **Opportunities and challenges**



# Opportunities

1. Students need a safe place, social space, individual & group study space, learning commons within the university campus / Transform library into active learning spaces, more digital content – less print materials, more learning tools, more flexible, etc.
2. Higher ICT/digital skills of the customers
3. Rich resources & discovering tools in library are essential for open & flexible learning environment of the university
4. Global initiatives to transform scholarly publishing system from subscription model to open access e.g. OA2020 and Plan S

# Challenges

1. Solving the problem of too expensive learning resources (imposed by commercial publishers)
2. The library still has little role in Education 4.0 ( e.g. driving a culture of creativity, critical thinking, innovation and entrepreneurial mindset in the university)
3. Continuous professional development : Improving knowledge and skills of library staff prepared for open, flexible learning & Education 4.0
4. Managing the library with strategic and modern management practices
